ACG Kinna uses cookies in order for the website, kinnaautomatic.com, to function as it should and to give you as a visitor a good user experience. Cookies on the ACG Kinna site are not necessary but can improve your experience. If you do not want to allow cookies to be stored on your device, you can change the settings in your browser. Through the browser, you can also delete previously saved cookies.

ACG Kinna uses permanent cookies and session cookies. Permanent cookies remain on your computer for a specified period of time. Session cookies are temporarily stored in a memory location while you visit our website and are deleted when you close your browser.
